A Parent's Guide for Traxx and Burton Learn to Ride for the 2020-2021 Winter Season



Ages:

Traxx (Ski): 5-12

Burton Learn to Ride (Snowboard): 6-12

What does the program offer?

Our Traxx and Burton Learn to Ride programs offer 2.5 hours of instruction in a fun group setting. We are offering two sessions, a morning and afternoon session for the 2020-2021 winter season. The program includes rental equipment, slope pass and 2.5 hrs of instruction. Burton Learn to Ride is for children that want to learn how to snowboard and the Traxx is for children that want to ski.

How do I register?

Save time and register online prior to arrival! This will also guarantee your child's spot in Traxx or Burton Learn to Ride. You will pay for registration online.

How should I dress my child and what should I bring?



All children are required to wear masks while participating in Traxx and Burton Learn to Ride. Masks need to be worn both inside and outside on the snow.

When dressing your child in the morning, it's good to start with a thin layer next to the skin - long johns or thermals. Layer according to the weather with a waterproof jacket and pants. Bring a winter hat, neck warmer and waterproof mittens if the temperatures look cold. All children are required to have gloves. Don't forget ski goggles or sunglasses. Use only one pair of socks, preferably ski socks as they keep kid's feet drier and warmer. We will not be offering snacks but feel free to pack some if you feel that your child might get hungry. You can also pack a water bottle to ensure your child is hydrated. Don't forget to apply/bring sunscreen!

Refund and Cancellation Policy:

All purchases are final and cannot be cancelled, refunded, changed or transferred. We do not guarantee snow conditions, weather conditions or open terrain. Your credit card account will be charged for the total amount of your purchase, regardless of whether or not the purchased ticket(s) is/are used. 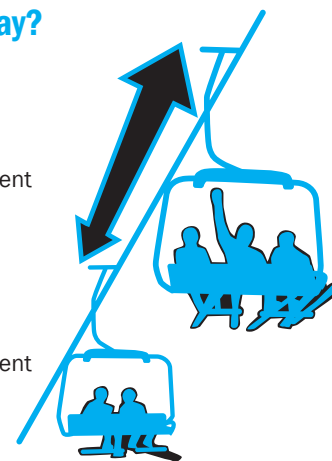

Where do I go?

Traxx (Ski) Program

Our Ski and Ride School building is located right across from our Play Yard (closest to Parking Lot 1). If you are checking in and have already purchased online, please proceed to the Traxx office located at the end of the ski and ride school building. You'll enter into Traxx through the glass door that is located at the top of the stairs, above the restrooms and locker room. A Traxx supervisor will be waiting to welcome you into the program.

Burton Learn to Ride (Snowboard) Program

Our Ski and Ride School building is located right across from our Play Yard (closest to Parking Lot 1). If you are checking in and have already purchased online, please proceed to the stairwell between the ski rental entrance and the ski rental exit. This stairwell goes up to the Burton Learn to ride school. There is a burton Learn to Ride Sign at the bottom of the stairwell. A supervisor will be waiting to welcome you into the program.

Please make sure to inform one of our supervisors of any allergies or relevant medical information.

Where do I return Equipment?

If you'll be returning equipment before 4:30, please return equipment in the Traxx or Burton Learn to Ride offices. If you'll be returning after 4:30, you can return at ski rental returns next to the Ski and Ride School lobby.

Covid 19 Guidelines

All children will be required to wear a mask while attending our programs.

A wellness check will be administered upon arrival before any child is admitted into our programs. If the child is showing any signs of illness, they will not be allowed to enter into our programs. All parent's will be required to wear a mask when dropping off children in the morning and interacting with our supervisors. Parents will not be permitted to enter into our programs or buildings.
