A PARENT'S GUIDE FOR SNOW KAMP FOR THE 2021-2022 WINTER SEASON

(Ages 3-5)

What does the program offer?

Our Snow Kamp program offers a fun introduction to an outdoor snow environment with skiing taking a back seat to fun. The program includes 4 hours of snow time, slope pass, ski rental equipment, helmet, and lunch.

What are the requirements?

Children must be age 3 to 5, toilet-trained and eager to learn to ski.

Please make sure to inform one of our supervisors of any allergies or relevant medical information.

How do I register?

Register online prior to arrival. This will guarantee your spot in Snow Kamp. You will pay for registration online.

How should I dress my child and what should I bring?

Start with a thin layer next to the skin - long johns or thermals. Layer according to the weather with waterproof jacket and pants. Bring a winter hat, neck warmer and waterproof mittens. Don't forget ski goggles or sunglasses. Use only one pair of socks, preferably ski socks as they keep kids' feet drier and warmer. It is highly recommended to bring an extra pair of underwear and pants just in case of an accident. Please bring extra snacks and a water bottle for the day. Don't forget to apply/bring sunscreen!



What is the schedule for the day?

4:30 p.m.	Equipment must be returned

Where do I go?

Our Snow Kamp/Traxx building is located right across from our Play Yard (closest to Parking Lot 1). If you are checking in, please proceed to the Snow Kamp office located at the end of the Snow Kamp/Traxx building. If you need to register and if there is availability, please proceed to the Ski & Ride School front desk.

If you have pre-registered online, check-in begins at 8:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. and will be located in the Snow Kamp office. Snow Kamp office is located all the way at the end of Ski & Ride School Building.
