A PARENT'S GUIDE FOR TRAXX AND BURTON LEARN TO RIDE FOR THE 2021-2022 WINTER SEASON



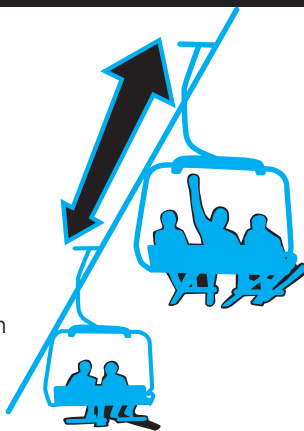

Traxx (Ski): 6-12

Burton Learn to Ride(Snowboard): 6-12

What does the program offer?

Our Traxx and Burton Learn to Ride programs offer all-day instruction in a fun group setting. The program includes all-day instruction, rental equipment, slope ticket, and lunch. Burton Learn to Ride is for children that want to learn how to snowboard and the Traxx Program is for children that want to ski.



How do I register?

Register online prior to arrival. This will also guarantee your child's spot in Traxx or Burton Learn to Ride. You will pay for registration online.

How should I dress my child and what should I bring?

When dressing your child in the morning, it's good to start with a thin layer next to the skin - long johns or thermals. Layer according to the weather with a waterproof jacket and pants. Bring a winter hat, neck warmer and waterproof mittens if the temperatures look cold. All children are required to have gloves. Don't forget ski goggles or sunglasses. Use only one pair of socks, preferably ski socks as they keep the child's feet drier and warmer. We will not be offering snacks but feel free to pack some if you feel that your child might get hungry. You can also pack a water bottle to ensure your child is hydrated. Don't forget to apply/bring sunscreen!

Where do I go?

Traxx (Ski) Program

Our Ski and Ride School building is located right across from our Play Yard (closest to Parking Lot 1). If you are checking in and have already purchased online, please proceed to the Traxx(Ski) office located at the end of the ski and ride school building. You'll enter

Traxx through the glass door that is located in front of the stairs that go down to the bathrooms and locker rooms. A traxx supervisor will be waiting to welcome you into the program.

If you need to register and if there is availability, please proceed to the Ski & Ride School front desk.

Burton Learn to Ride (Snowboard) Program

Our Ski and Ride School building is located right across from our Play Yard (closest to Parking Lot 1). If you are checking in and have already purchased online, please proceed to the stairwell between the ski rental entrance and the ski rental exit. This stairwell goes up to the Burton Learn to ride school. There is a Burton Learn to Ride Sign at the bottom of the stairwell. A supervisor will be waiting to welcome you into the program.

If you need to register and if there is availability, please proceed to the Ski & Ride School front desk.

Please make sure to inform one of our supervisors of any allergies or relevant medical information.

Where do I return Equipment?

All equipment must be returned to the Traxx or Burton Learn to Ride office.
